

New “SSLPost Lite” Solution for Invoices and Statements

1. An overview of “SSLPost Lite”

“SSLPost Lite” introduces a simpler method of opening SSLPost email messages and is targeted specifically for use with Invoices and Statements. The solution allows messages and attachments to be opened by the recipient without the requirement for a password.

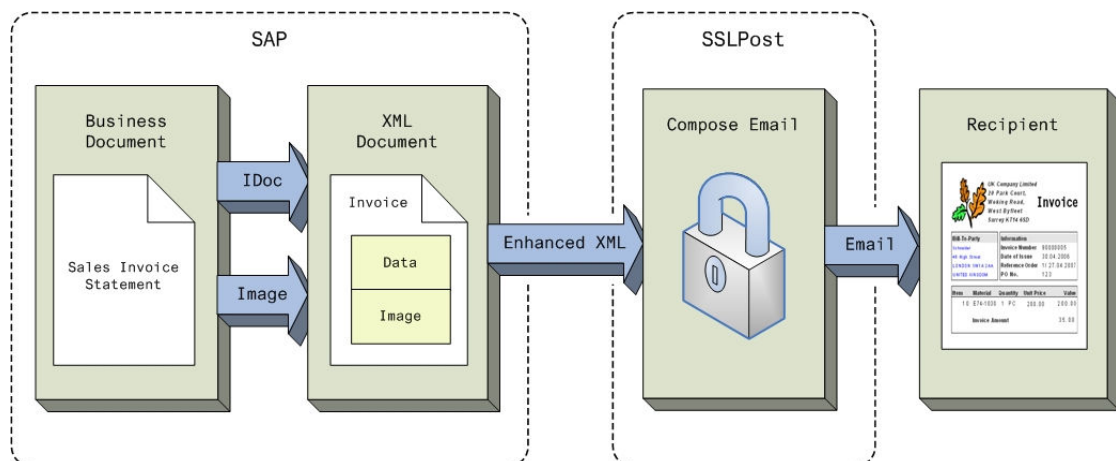
This product offers many benefits over the “unsecured” send option. The solution retains the security of the message during transmission*, and provides a full audit trail facility.

** The communication is secure up to the point of receipt by the email recipient. “SSLPost Lite” cannot store documents securely on the recipient’s computer, therefore this solution is not recommended for confidential documents such as payslips.*

It is easy to switch from “SSLPost Lite” to full SSLPost security (and vice-versa).

2. High level process

The diagram illustrates the basic process.



- The SAP business document is converted to XML
- The XML is sent securely from SAP to the SSLPost server.
- SSLPost generates a PDF and encrypts the message with a seal.
- Recipient opens the email and clicks the decode button in the message body.
- The seal key is retrieved from SSLPost and the message content is decrypted.
- The content of the email message is displayed and the recipient can view their PDF document.

3. Pros and Cons

Pros	Cons
No requirement for a decrypt password	Documents cannot be held securely by SSLPost on the recipient computer. Any user with access to the recipients email client can view the messages.
